Minutes of November Meeting:

MOVED to approve minutes: Biljana, Eva. **Correction:** under Attendees, spelling is Teena Aujla, not Tina. Johnna will correct this. MOTION CARRIED.

Graduation Events:

- Kaitlee submitted a proposal to support the "Breakfast with Santa" event (added to New Business)
- There is a grad student committee, but we need parents involved if there is going to be a prom
- SB: last minute planning is more expensive and problematic. Helpful if planners have theatre connections: support with lx, dj, décor
- Biljana and Eva: have a binder full of planning info from last year
- Biljana: the planning committee will need to apply for grants ASAP
- Tania: the PAC cannot plan Prom, we need a separate committee
- JW: get kids on the Grad Committee to visit classrooms; use the PAC table at PT conferences to reach
- out to people
- JW: Grad Committee kids should rope their parents into the Prom Committee
- Katie: it helps if parents of other grades also get involved, even if it's just on the night itself
- Sonia: will set up a grade 12 meeting and include discussion about prom + other grad activities
- Biljana: she and Eva could onboard a parent Prom committee in January
- Last year the students paid \$60 to attend; cost of prom was ~\$20K
- There are about 100 kids in Grade 12, last year about 85 attended.
- Biljana: the cruise was the easiest option
- Sonia: not easiest for the school!
- Sonia: there are plug-and-play companies, you pay more, but they take care of everything
- Eva: according to a survey, in the end 70% of last year's grad students preferred to have a "Land Prom" at Heritage Hall instead of a "Cruise Prom"
- Kaitlee: Heritage House was a good venue last time
- Marion: will be on the committee but can't lead it

Teena joined 6:25 p.m.

- Andrea: it would be helpful for parents to know what they would be signing up for
- JW: I'll have a signup sheet at the PT night
- January PAC meeting is the deadline to sign up

Principal's Report:

- the Remembrance day assembly went very well, Indigenous veterans were also honored
- community-building events: two staff vs. students games
- the Roughriders pep band came and played at the school
- IB Info Night did not have big attendance, how can we pump that up? Eva: do we go out to other schools? (Sonia thinks yes)
- Indigenous Fashion Week: "Girls Who Leap" program
- The Cave, the school store, has opened. They went with a different card processing system.
- Seattle Marathon was this weekend, some students participated as well as Katie!
- Core Competencies looks like no one on the PAC received an email about it, Sonia will check to see if the messages are being sent. Some kids are not taking it seriously,
- "Safe Teens" program for grades 8 & 9 about harassment, safety, sexual health
- Winter Concert Dec 17
- Winter Break Dec 23-Jan 5

Chair's Report:

- PAC table for PT night.
 - It will have coffee and treats by donation.
 - Caitlin: can bring coffee from JJ Bean and TimBits
- Agenda for meetings.
 - What is the process, who makes up the agenda
 - Biljana: secretary should do it (Anita or Teena)
 - Doesn't necessarily need to be Mailchimp
 - Send to the Executive a week in advance, then to the membership with any changes.

Treasurer's Report:

- Money is the same as last time
- The PAC has two accounts: Gaming (government) and a regular chequing account, which has \$1,400.00 we received from the district, this should be spent on community building.
- Teachers' lunch doesn't qualify, the funds have been borrowed from that account and should be replaced by fundraised revenue
- We have to plan a community-building event
- Sonia: thought about doing PAC donations?
 - Valorie: do we have regular or past donors?
 - Caitlin: are donations tax deductible?
 - Biljana: yes, if they go through the school
 - Valorie: reach out to people in the area?
 - Biljana: need a fundraising committee!
 - Valorie: can't do it personally, but happy to advise
 - Tania: some private schools have sister relationships with public schools
 - Fundraising Committee to be struck in January
 - Valorie: where do we direct people?
 - Sonia: to the PAC email (& Johnna will remember to check it)
- DPAC and BCPAC:
 - Biljana proposes we don't pay membership fee for BCPAC right now (\$75) because they are undergoing some executive change

MOVED to not pay the BCPAC membership at present: Biljana, Johnna. MOTION PASSED.

- We need a volunteer to attend DPAC meetings
- Caitlin volunteers to attend DPAC and will be interested at the meetings!
- Biljana will send Caitlin the info
